Objective:

Rich Beyer was a long time Bedford resident who was very involved in youth athletics in town. He was best known as a coach of the Bedford Little League World Series team and host of sports related shows on BCTV. He believed that participation in high school athletics is a very important part of your total high school experience. **The objective of the Rich Beyer Athletic Scholarship is to recognize two Bedford High School student – athletes (one male and one female) who epitomize leadership, character, dedication, team spirit, enthusiasm and sportsmanship.**

Scholarship:

\$1,000. each for one male athlete and one female athlete to be awarded at Senior Night.

Eligibility:

- Must be a Bedford High School graduating senior
- Must be planning to attend a postsecondary program
- Must be a student in good academic standing (minimum B average)
- Must exemplify qualities of a good citizen
- Must have been a member of a BHS varsity athletic team

Requirements:

- Completed application
- Essay
- Official transcript
- A total of 3 letters of reference, including at least one from a BHS school official (Administrator, Guidance Counselor, Teacher) and one from a coach
