### **Objective:**

Rich Beyer was a long time Bedford resident who was very involved in youth athletics in town. He was best known as a coach of the Bedford Little League World Series team and the host of sports related shows on BCTV. The objective of the Rich Beyer Athletic Scholarship is to recognize two Bedford High School student – athletes (one male and one female) who epitomize leadership, character, dedication, team spirit, enthusiasm, and sportsmanship. For 2026, the Booster Club is happy to continue this scholarship in memory of such a pillar of the community of Bedford. Winners are contacted by the BBABC.

### **Scholarship:**

\$1,000. each for one male athlete and one female athlete to be awarded by the BBABC.

### **Eligibility:**

- Must be a Bedford High School graduating senior
- Must be planning to attend a postsecondary program
- Must be a student in good academic standing (minimum B average)
- Must exemplify qualities of a good citizen
- Must have been a member of a BHS varsity athletic team

### **Requirements:**

- Completed application
- Essay
- Official transcript
- A total of 2 letters of reference, one from a coach and one from a mentor
